## **Gulfstream Donates \$50,000 to Corporate Angel Network**

White Plains, NY – Corporate Angel Network has received a \$50,000 donation from Gulfstream Aerospace Corporation in support of the organization’s work to arrange free flights to treatment for cancer patients using empty seats in business aircraft.

“Companies that operate their own corporate aircraft can make a huge contribution to easing the load and brightening the lives of those touched by cancer,” said Joseph T. Lombardo, President of Gulfstream Aerospace and Executive Vice President, Aerospace, of its parent company, General Dynamics.

“By donating empty seats on regular business flights, these corporations reduce the worry, discomfort and extra cost of the distant travel for critical and often life-saving treatment that so many patients must endure,” Lombardo said. He was elected to Corporate Angel’s Board of Directors in late 2009.

Randall Greene, President of Safe Flight Instrument Corporation and Corporate Angel Network’s Chairman said that Gulfstream Aerospace and its parent company, General Dynamics, have been strong participants in Corporate Angel Network, donating space on corporate flights for more than 25 years.
